Dear Student,

We are looking forward to having you join the Ezra Academy family in September and are sending you some information to get you started.

School will begin with orientation and Hebrew placement on Wednesday, September 1st at 9 a.m. All students are to report to the fourth floor Bais Medrash (do not use the elevator, please) for an assembly, which will be followed by meeting the student who is assigned to be your "Big Brother or Sister." You will then meet with a panel of Hebrew teachers who will test you and place you in your Hebrew Studies classes, after which you will receive your General Studies schedule. You should be done before noon. Regular classes begin the following day, Thursday September 2nd at 8 a.m.
